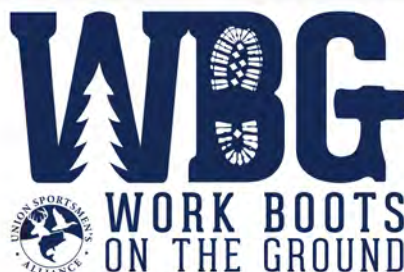
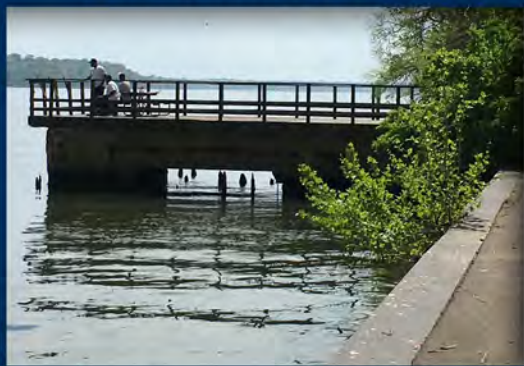

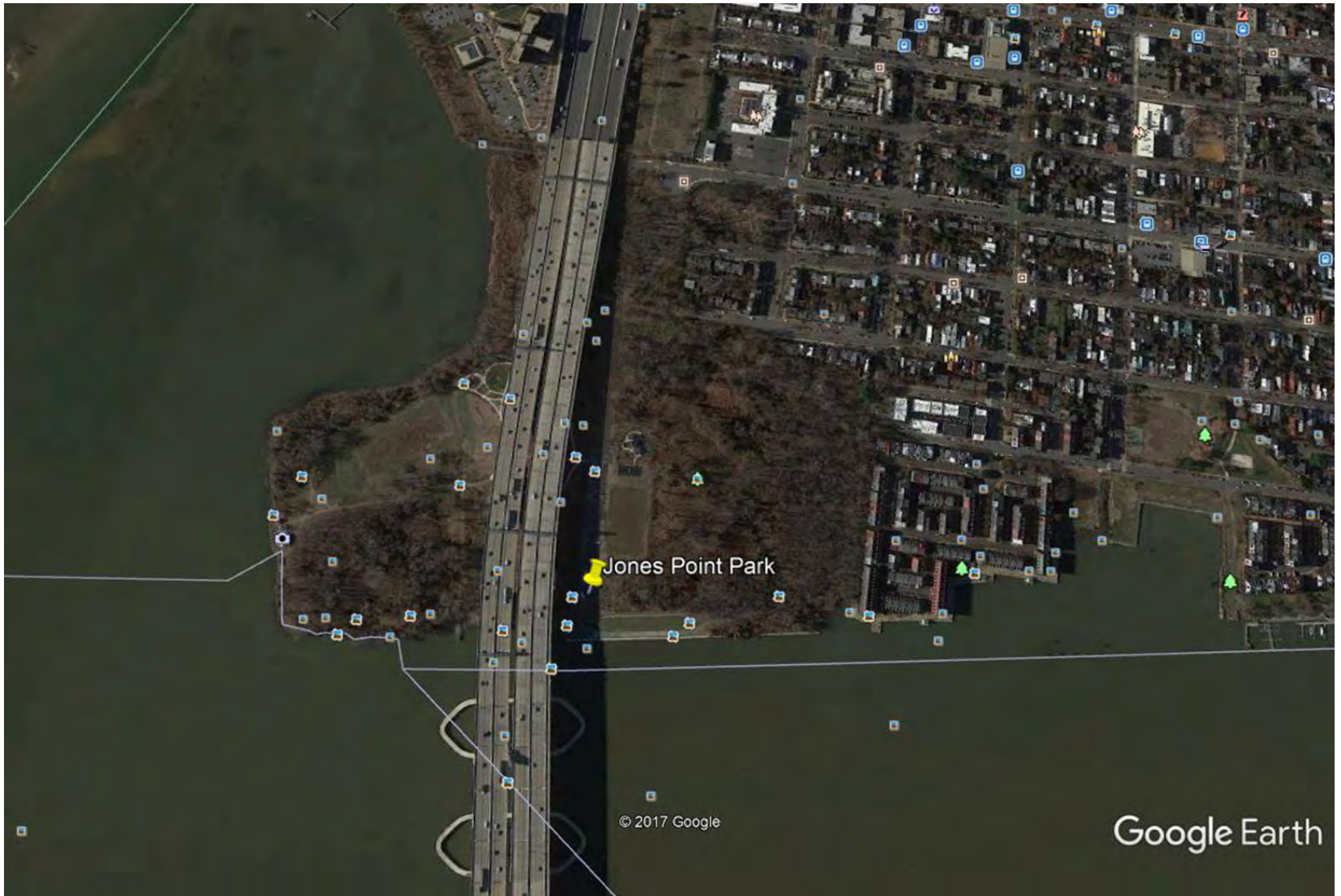
This is a major undertaking, and we need your help!
