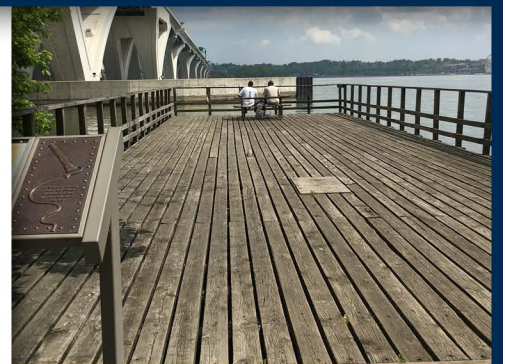
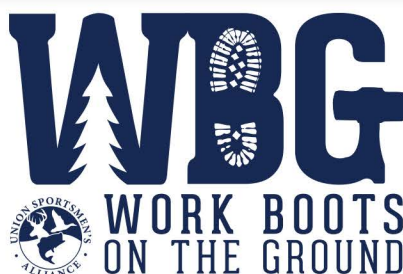
This is a major undertaking, and we need your help!

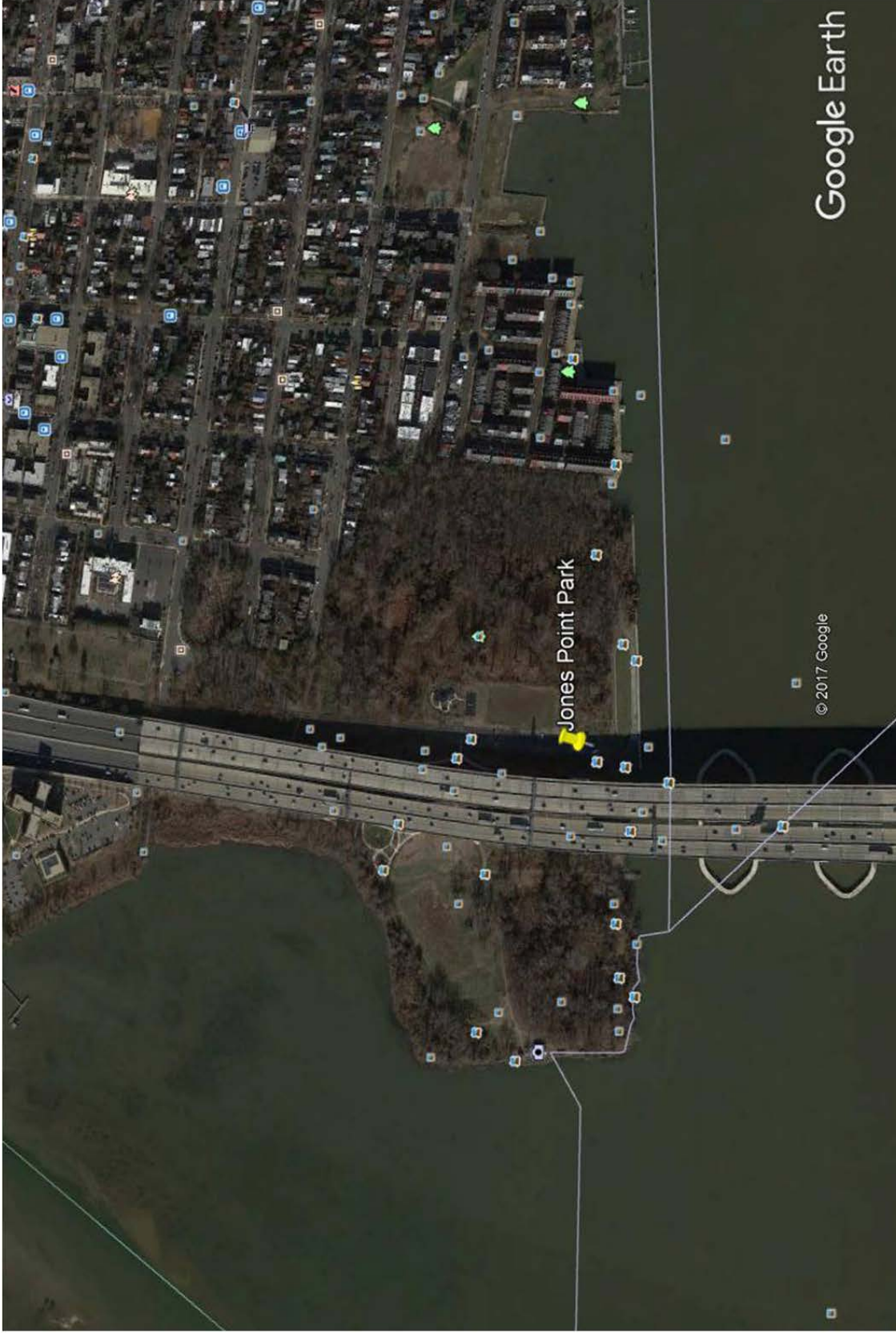
On the first work day, we will deconstruct the existing pier, remove debris and prep the site for the new pier. Volunteers of all skill levels are welcome.
